

JOB DESCRIPTION FOR LIFEGUARD

POSITION: Lifeguard

RESPONSIBLE TO: Program Team Supervisors

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Has accepted Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord and is pursuing a growing relationship with Him.
2. Minimum 18 years of age
3. Standard First Aid / CPR
4. NLS Certification
5. Police Record Check is required upon application.

RESPONSIBILITIES

General:

1. Actively pursue and encourage a Christ-centered, discipling focus.
2. Care for the needs of his/her job.
3. Broaden the campers' interests.
4. Co-operate with and assist other staff members.
5. Participate in all staff meetings and general sessions.
6. Keep accurate records and report as required.
7. Be an example by following camp rules and regulations.
8. Welcome, encourage and help volunteers.

Specifics:

1. Plan and lead an indoor pool swimming program for campers grades 2 to 12, as well as younger children and adults during Family Camp.
2. Take responsibility for the SAFETY-consciousness of the program, the campers, and the staff. Be prepared to intervene in any emergency situations.
3. Incorporate spiritual application during swimming sessions.
4. Plan and lead pool activities and games for the swimming sessions.
5. Assess swimming abilities of campers throughout sessions.
6. Order all necessary equipment for the swimming program, in consultation with the Program Team Supervisor, one week in advance.
7. Care for and maintain all pool equipment. Model and promote safe and responsible use of equipment.
8. Keep the pool area clean and neat. Check chlorine, acid levels, and temperature of pools twice a day.
9. Take inventory at the beginning and close of summer camp.
10. Give leadership and/or help in the children's program during Family Camps.
11. Support, train, disciple and give leadership opportunities to LDTs assigned to the pool.
12. Assist with drama and worship team according to skills and giftings.
13. Assist in Sunday camper registration and Saturday camper pick-up as assigned.
14. Attend and participate in all Campfires, unless involved in other camp duties. Work with other staff to maintain an effective atmosphere.
15. Host meals as required within Program Team scheduling.
