

JOB DESCRIPTION FOR SPORTS LEADER

POSITION: Sports Leader

RESPONSIBLE TO: Program Team Supervisors

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Has accepted Jesus Christ as Saviour and Lord and is pursuing a growing relationship with Him.
2. Minimum 18 years of age
3. Standard First Aid / CPR
4. Police Record Check is required upon application.

RESPONSIBILITIES

General:

1. Actively pursue and encourage a Christ-centered, discipling focus.
2. Care for the needs of his/her job.
3. Broaden the campers' interests.
4. Co-operate with and assist other staff members.
5. Participate in all staff meetings and general sessions.
6. Keep accurate records and report as required.
7. Be an example by following camp rules and regulations.
8. Welcome, encourage and help volunteers.

Specifics:

1. Develop and operate a program of guidance and instruction in a wide variety of recreational activities, geared to the ages and abilities of the campers.
2. Take responsibility for the SAFETY-consciousness of the sports program, the campers, and the staff.
3. Incorporate spiritual application during sports sessions.
4. Organize and lead all games, team sports, icebreakers and evening special activities for all camps. (Grades 2 to 12).
5. Plan and lead sports activities and evening specials during Family Camps. (Note: This requires a much different approach than other camps).
6. Order all necessary equipment for recreational activities and evening specials, in consultation with the Program Team Supervisor, one week in advance.
7. Care for and maintain all sports equipment. Model and promote safe and responsible use of equipment.
8. Keep the sports cabinets neat, clean and orderly.
9. Take inventory at the beginning and close of summer camp.
10. Organize special recreational events in conjunction with the Program Team Supervisors: Grade 4/5/6 Campathon, Junior High Blitz, High School Beach Day and tournaments, etc.
11. Give leadership and/or help in the children's program during Family Camps.
12. Organize and promote the adults water polo game for Family Camps.
13. Support, train, disciple and give leadership opportunities to LDTs assigned to sports.
14. Assist with drama and worship team according to skills and giftings.
15. Assist in Sunday camper registration and Saturday camper pick-up as assigned.
16. Attend and participate in all Campfires, unless involved in other camp duties. Work with other staff to maintain an effective atmosphere.
17. Host meals as required within Program Team scheduling.
